The following is a clarification to the official regulations already issued for the above Championship within the rights reserved in Art. 1.1. of the Championship Regulations. These will be implemented immediately or as shown subject to Motorsport UK yearbook regulations.

AMENDMENT

Current Regulations

1.5 Championship Rounds

The 2020 Caterham Academy Championship will be contested over seven events with the drivers split into two parallel and approximately equal groups (to cater for the large number of entrants), Green Group and White Group, for the duration of the season. The event are as follows:
