## REGULATION AMENDMENTS & CLARIFICATION

## 2020 BRSCC Caterham Seven 310R Championship

The following is a clarification to the official regulations already issued for the above Championship within the rights reserved in Art. 1.1. of the Championship Regulations. These will be implemented immediately or as shown subject to Motorsport UK yearbook regulations.

## **AMENDMENT**

**Current Regulations** 

- 5.12 Wheels & Steering
- 5.12.1 Permitted Options

Use of 6" x 13" 'Apollo' style aluminium wheels as supplied by Caterham under part number 30W044A (Silver), 30W041A (black/polished) or 30W029A (Hi-Power silver) is mandatory.

The wheels may be painted any colour.

The wheels are supplied with a plastic centre cap and badge as standard. These must be removed for practice and races.

#### **New Regulation**

- 5.12 Wheels & Steering
- 5.12.1 Permitted Options

Use of 6" x 13" 'Apollo' style aluminium wheels as supplied by Caterham under part number 30W044A (Silver), 30W041A (black/polished) or 30W029A (Hi-Power silver) or 6" x 13" 'Caterham Motorsport 8 spoke' wheels, part number 77296, is mandatory. The wheels may be painted any colour. Any combination of the above Apollo type wheels may be used as required, but it is not permitted to use a combination of Apollo and 8-spoke wheels.

The wheels are supplied with a plastic centre cap and badge as standard. These must be removed for practice and races.

#### Reason

The change permits the use of the previous generation race wheel (simply known as the '8-spoke') due to an ongoing short-term supply issue with the current Apollo style wheel from Caterham.
