REGULATION AMENDMENTS & CLARIFICATION

2021 Fun Cup Endurance Championship

The following is a clarification to the official regulations already issued for the above Championship within the rights reserved in Art. 1.1. of the Championship Regulations. These will be implemented immediately or as shown subject to Motorsport UK yearbook regulations.

AMENDMENT

Current Regulation

5.15.5 Only Pump Fuel as defined in Motorsport UK General Regulations Section B Nomenclature and Definitions (see Pump Fuel)] may be used. The use of any type of fuel additives are strictly prohibited.

New Regulation

5.15.5 Only petrol as defined in General Regulations Section B Nomenclature & Definitions, Pump Fuel (a) section of the Motorsport UK Yearbook and complying with BSEN228 may be used. The use of type of fuel additives in any petrol is strictly prohibited.

Reason

It has been highlighted that with the current wording in section 5.15.5 referring to pump fuel, teams could use 102 octane fuel. The aim is to keep fuel costs down by restricting the octane rating to pump fuel from Public filling stations which is normally 95 to 99 octane, therefore, the fuel used must not exceed 100 octane. This restriction ensures a level playing field for all competitors.
