

COVID-19 guidelines summary for competitors

Remember our events are still running under Scottish Government and Motorsport UK COVID-19 guidelines and there are some key points that all our participants and support teams must bear in mind

- No under 16's are allowed into the paddock please do not bring children as part of your support crew
- ◆ Drivers can bring a maximum of 3 essential team personnel into the meeting who's names must have been provided to us 9am on Friday as part of the event sign on process. A list of pre-nominated personnel will be held at the gate for admission control on Sunday − if you are not on our list, we won't be able to let you into the venue so drivers, please make sure you provide us with all your support crews details.
- Face coverings must be worn at all times (unless you're eating / drinking or you are wearing a helmet). Please note Medical exemptions to wearing a face mask do not apply at Motorsport UK events.
- Social distancing must be observed and teams must remain in their bubbles at all times.
- ◆ All drivers and teams will be restricted to the paddock areas for the event you cannot travel out of the paddock, into the spectator areas.
- ◆ Knockhill have permission to have 250 spectators on site. Spectators must have prebooked with the circuit in advance and will access the venue via a separate entrance. Spectators will not have access to the paddock area.
