ANGLESEY CIRCU

WEEKEND PREVIEW

For the first time since November 2019, the BRSCC will take a trip to that most picturesque of circuits in North Wales as Anglesey finally welcomes motorsport back after an extended enforced absence thanks to the restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Club is ready to make a triumphant return to racing action by the coast, and brings an abundance of sports cars, single seaters, superkarts, saloon cars and even endurance racing to mark what's sure to be a fantastic weekend.

Two championships essentially share the headline slot this weekend, with the first competing on Saturday and racing late into the night. The Fun Cup Endurance Championship is now two races old in 2021 and UVio/ Hofmann's Lotus has reigned supreme in both of them, but now comes a tough double header with two three-hour races. The first will take place in the afternoon before a break allows teams to regroup and go ahead for a special second race starting in the twilights and racing into the darkness. This isn't the first time that Fun Cup has contested an "into the night" race, but nonetheless the occasion will certainly look and feel special for everyone involved. It will be tough for leading drivers "Farquini" and Fabio Randaccio to hold off the opposition from Despatch Bay Express, Team Viking, GCI Racing and MJ Tec Giti, but they will certainly be trying to secure a third win on the bounce, something that doesn't normally happen! In addition, this will be the only championship this weekend which will contest their races on the Coastal circuit layout, while the rest will all race the full International configuration.

The other co-headline act will be the second meeting of the year for the new Motorsport UK British Superkart Championship, which is already underway after its opening rounds at Mallory Park a couple of months ago. Anglesey will certainly provide a unique test for this rapid little machines which are set to compete in four separate classes all on track together at once, with Division One, F250 National, F450 National and Formula 125 Open all ready to race. Ross Allen, Lee Plain, Mark Gellatly and Tom Riley all lead their respective points tables and will be hoping to maintain their advantage in each come the end of the weekend, which is set to be another triple header featuring three races.

One car that we won't be short of in Wales is Mazda MX-5s as a phalanx of Mk1s and Mk3s descend to contest all three championships that will be in attendance. The Mazda MX-5 Championship is already shaping up to be a classic this year with three drivers having taken at least one win each and two of them doing so for the first time. Croft's hat-trick hero Jack Brewer couldn't quite match his form from Yorkshire as he was caught up in incidents and all-round bad luck, leaving the top step to be taken by Fraser Fenwick and then a long-awaited pair of wins for Steve Foden, success that had been a long time coming. Brewer will be aiming to bounce back at Anglesey and take the fight to his two newest challengers, while Brian Trott, Oliver Allwood, Sebastian Fisher, Oliver Graham and Zak Oates will be among their main pursuers all weekend.

The new Mazda MX-5 Clubman Championship is also taking shape nicely after it reached a superb 30+ car grid at the previous rounds at Silverstone. While the entry is a little smaller than that this time, make no mistake that the quality of the racing will still make for a fine spectacle to watch. Harry Storer is still the man in command in the points after he added to his double at Croft with a win amongst the points-scoring drivers at Silverstone, but there's going to be stiff opposition from the Steel City MX-5 pairing of Kevin Bird and Rob Greensmith, plus Peter Higton, Dan Blake and familiar names such as Alan Hawkins, Jake Styles and newcomer Charles Boniface.

Over in the Mazda MX-5 SuperCup, it too is looking likely to be a memorable year as now four drivers has tasted victory from the first six races. Defending champion Samuel Smith now leads the way by five points from Jack Harding, who managed to pick up his first win back as a full time racer in the series, while double Croft winner Patrick Fletcher had a mixed Silverstone experience with a third win of the year. James Cossins, the last of the four winners so far, is also still in close attention, plus you can expect drivers such as John Langridge, Masters points leader Simon Baldwin, Will Blackwell-Chambers and Adam Bessell to give all four of these guys a runaround in Wales. Richard Armos will also be looking to extend his lead in the Club class too after his rapid pace last time out.

Formula Ford is back in action with both the National Formula Ford and Northern & Super Classic Formula Ford championships combining onto one grid this weekend for the first time since they did so for 2020. In the National ranks, battlelines are being drawn as new points leader Max Esterson now has to fend off both former leader Alex Walker and David Leslie Trophy winner Chris Middlehurst in what's setting up to be a titanic battle for the title. Over in the Northern ranks, class points leaders Paul Mason (Super Classic A), Nick Barnes (Super Classic B) and Ian Fernihough (Super Classic D) are all out in force to defend their places at the head of their respective tables, while Neil McArthur looks let to be a force in the sole P Class car amongst a healthy mix of Van Diemens, Reynards and Swifts.

Plus, the saloon car action element of the weekend comes from the exceptional Modified Ford Series, who join us for the second time this year after a memorable BRSCC debut at Donington Park which featured a grid of over 30 cars. Dave Cockelt's souped-up Ford Escort Cosworth (which charged from the back of the grid to win the second Donington race) has to start as the favourite to win at least one of Sunday's pair of races, with some of his competitions likely to come from Malcolm Wise's own Escort Cosworth, the Mk2 Escorts of Paul Nevill and Piers Grange and many others that will be looking for class glory.





YELLOW/WAVED:

Danger, no overtaking, slow down with full control of the vehicle.

YELLOW/DOUBLE WAVED:

Great danger, no overtaking, slow down considerably, be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line or even stop. This signal may be supplemented or replaced by flashing yellow lights.



RED:

Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals; (at startline and individual marshals posts).



YELLOW WITH RED STRIPES:

Slippery surface ahead



REEN.

Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

GREEN/WAVED:

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and shown at all posts during first lap of each practice session and during the formation lap.



BLUE/STEADY:

Another competitor is close.

BLUE/WAVED:

Another competitor is trying to pass



BLACK DISPLAY WITH WHITE NUMBER:

Driver must call in immediately and report to the clerk of the course



BLACK/ORANGE DISC DISPLAYED WITH WHITE NUMBER:

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately



BLACK/WHITE RECTANGULAR WITH WHITE NUMBER:

Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged



WHITE:

Signifies service vehicle is on course



BLACK/WHITE CHEOUERED:

End of race.
