REGULATION AMENDMENTS & CLARIFICATION

2021 W SERIES

The following is an amendment to the official regulations already issued for the above Championship within the rights reserved in the ISC. These will be implemented immediately.

AMENDMENT

- 8.1 The 2021 W Series will be contested over 8 rounds as set out below. Should any W Series round or race be cancelled by the organisers for whatever reason the W Series championship will remain valid providing a minimum of 6 races have been completed.

W Series retains the right to organise up to 3 non-championship rounds at selected venues.

- 38.3 Prior to the first race of the season each driver will be allocated a chassis which, subject to Art. 36.2 above, will be retained for the duration of the season.

Following the first round, and for each subsequent round **at different venues**, the drivers who finish first, second and third will have the complete drivetrain (engine, gearbox, and associated electronics) swapped out for the corresponding components selected at random by the eligibility scrutineer from competitors finishing the same race between sixth and fourteenth positions, always ensuring that any driver never uses the same drivetrain twice in the same championship season.

Where there are multiple rounds at the same venue/event, the organiser reserves the right to amend the above format and it may be necessary for the same drivetrain (engine, gearbox, and associated electronics) to be used to practice and qualify for both rounds at the same event, but the drivetrain may be changed for the second round at that event.

Reason

Cancellation of Round 8 at Mexico due to logistical challenges. Round 8 replaced with a second round at Austin, USA. All registered competitors have been informed of the above changes by email and have responded before 1st October.
