Regulations Amendments & Clarification

## Intelligent Money British GT Championship

Bulletin Number: 04

**Date of Implementation:** 22 July 2022

Championship Permit No: CH2022/R002

The following amendments to the Championship Regulations are of immediate effect pursuant to the permission of Motorsport UK applying NCR A.2.4 exempting the Organisers from the requirement to obtain the consent of Competitors under NCRs D.11.1.1 and 11.2. All additions are underlined and in red text. Where appropriate, deletions are shown by strikethrough.

## Amendment to Article 4.4.1:

4.4.1 Drivers involved in Incidents of any kind, or who have been reported for unsportsmanlike behaviour or driving standards, may, in addition to their penalty, be awarded Behaviour Warning Points (BWP) by the Race Director.

The following scale may apply, subject to the decision of the Race Director:

- reprimand 1 Behaviour Warning Point
- drive-through penalty 1 Behaviour Warning Point
- pit lane speeding 1 Behaviour Warning Point for speeds between 52 km/h and 65 km/h and two BWP over 65 km/h
- stop-and-go penalty 2 Behaviour Warning Points
- causing a collision 1 or 2 Behaviour Warning Points depending on the severity of the offence

Other offences may give rise to BWP as decided by the Race Director.

Behaviour Warning Points will only be awarded to drivers for their own actions, not those of the Team or Team-mates (e.g. pit stop infringements, track limits). The number of BWP awarded will be listed on the official event noticeboard.

The number of BWP will be calculated per driver and the following penalties imposed:

- A driver with 3 points will receive a drop of 5 grid positions for the car in which he is driving for the next race
- A driver with 4 points will receive a drop of 10 grid positions for the car in which he is driving for the next race
- A driver with 5 points or more will receive a minimum of a drive-through penalty for the car in which he is driving, to be applied at the next race.



After these penalties have been imposed and the penalty has been taken, the driver will have 3 Behaviour Warning Points deducted from their score and the remainder will be carried forward to the next Competition in which the driver takes part. the drivers score will be reset to zero.

Behaviour Warning Points will be carried forward to the next event.

Negative scores will not be taken into account.

By decision of the Race Director, Behaviour Warning Points may be carried over between any rounds of the Intelligent Money British GT Championship.
