Please note that no tickets will be issued for this meeting. The Circuit Management will be provided with a list of Marshals and Officials for each day.

#### **RACE MEETING CONTENT**

This meeting is on the **International** circuit, and features the Race of Remembrance on all three days, plus the ClubSport Trophy (a two driver 45 minute race for production based cars) on Saturday.

As you're probably aware the Race of Remembrance runs into the evening on Saturday so it will be a longer day than normal; albeit with breaks. Necessarily, there will be night qualifying on Friday evening as well; the plan is to finish no later than 1900 hrs (Friday) and 2200 hrs (Saturday). We are pleased to offer marshals vouchers each day that may be used in exchange for meals and drinks.
