You will receive e-tickets which you will need to print off and bring with you to gain access to the circuit; or show the e-ticket on a smartphone.

Remember that the signing on process is online only - the easiest way to sign on is to use the BRSCC RaceHub, accessible from the Club's website. Alternatively, a sign on page can be found on the appropriate event page at www.brscc.co.uk.
