On behalf of the BRSCC North West Centre and Committee may I thank you very much for assisting at our Race of Remembrance 2025 race meeting. This race meeting is the jewel in the crown of our whole season in the North West, and so your support and contribution for this weekend is certainly both valued and appreciated!

ADMISSION

Please note that no tickets will be issued for this meeting. The Circuit Management will be provided with a list of marshals and officials for each day.

CHECK IN TIMES

Friday 7th November: 1230 - 1310 to be on post by 1325. Saturday 8th November: 0750 - 0825 to be on post by 0840. Sunday 9th November: 0750 - 0825 to be on post by 0840.

CHECK IN LOCATIONS

Post chiefs and flag marshals in the café with the Chief Marshal (Margaret Simpson).

Incident marshals also in the café with the Deputy Chief Marshal (Duncan Fitz-Gibbons).

If the weather is dry, please wait outside on the decked area. You will then use the double doors to enter the café and check in.

Specialist marshals should check in at their post location.

There will be a post chief and flag marshal briefing each day at the end of check in.

RACE MEETING CONTENT

This meeting is on the **International** circuit and features the Race of Remembrance on all three days, plus the ClubSport Trophy (a two driver 45 minute race for production based cars) on Saturday.

As you're probably aware the Race of Remembrance runs into the evening on Saturday so it will be a longer day than normal, albeit with breaks. Necessarily, there will be night qualifying on Friday evening as well. The plan is to finish no later than 1905 hrs (Friday) and 2205 hrs (Saturday).

MEAL VOUCHERS

We are pleased to offer marshals vouchers for £6 each day that may be used in exchange for meals and non-alcoholic drinks at the circuit cafe. You will receive all your vouchers for the weekend when you first check in. There will be no change given when using them.

There will also be the opportunity to gift your unused vouchers back to Mission Motorsport.
