

2026 CITYCAR CUP – MANDATORY ECU MAP

Ahead of competing the 2026 race season, all City Car Cup cars will be required to undergo a mandatory ECU inspection and sealing process.

As part of this process, competitors must send their ECU's to the championship ECU map provider, Hybrid Tune, where the following will be carried out:

- Verification and equalisation of ECU calibration
- Logging and sealing of the ECU unit
- Removal of the immobiliser system

The removal of the immobiliser will allow Eligibility Scrutineers, where required, to utilise championship-controlled ECU units to ensure full compliance with series regulations.

This requirement is mandatory for all City Car Cup cars, including both Gen1 and Gen2 models, and must be completed prior to competing in the 2026 season.

Cost

The cost for this service is £195 + VAT (£234.00 inc. VAT), plus return shipping.
