Following investigation and having heard evidence from the competitor I find that, you are found guilty of contravening Motorsport UK Regulation (s):

Q 15.1 (e/f) – Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

A waved yellow flag was displayed at Marshals Post 19, Coppice Corner as a car was in the gravel trap. Timekeeping lap analysis, data logging and onboard video evidence show that Car 50 set his fastest Sector 2 time of the qualifying session while a waved Yellow Flag was displayed.
